### SWIMMING AT LANSING POOL

Lansing Pool will open June 29th and will remain open until mid-August. Pool hours will be Noon–7pm, weather permitting.

FREE Swimming Lessons will be offered for two weeks beginning July 6th. More information on swimming lessons will be available at the pool office once they have opened for the season.

Swimming at Lansing Pool will again be FREE for COHOES RESIDENTS but please remember that you must show proof of residency upon entering the pool. Proof of residence can be shown by presenting one of the following items:

- Current Cohoes City School ID or Report Card
- Drivers License

- Current Utility Bill
- Current City of Cohoes Tax Bill

Non-residents will be charged \$5.00 per day to use the pool facility.

The City of Cohoes would also like to remind you that any children under the age of 12 wishing to swim at the pool, MUST be accompanied by an adult. Young children who are dropped off at the pool alone will not be able to swim due to safety concerns.

Adult Swim will be held on Tuesday evenings from 6-7:30PM weather permitting. This means that all youth must vacate the pool by 6pm.

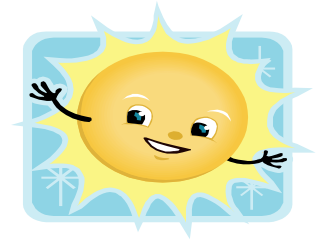
# SUMMER SPORTS ACADEMY

- July 21-25 LACROSSE

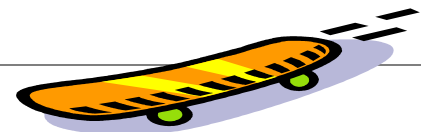

**The City of Cohoes has posted rules at the Skate Park and is reminding everyone, skate boarders and in-line skaters, that you MUST WEAR A HELMET IN ORDER TO USE THE PARK. Anyone seen without a helmet on will be asked to leave the park and will lose their privileges to use the park for the entire season.**

New York State has passed a law stating that anyone 14 years or younger must wear a helmet when

skating. Therefore the rules on Helmet Use are strict and we are asking that everyone abide by them.

**The Skate Park is free and open to Cohoes residents only.** A waiver must still be filled out for anyone wishing to use the park. A parent/guardian signature will be required for anyone under age 18. Waivers are available on-line at [www.ci.cohoes.ny.us](http://www.ci.cohoes.ny.us), at the skate park, or in City Hall Room 20. Anyone under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult while at the skate park.
