MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON MARCH 17, 2008

Chairman Johnston called the meeting to order at 4:25P.M. He stated that the first item on the agenda was approval of the minutes of the Traffic Commission meeting held on March 17, 2008. He asked if there were any questions, concerns, comments or corrections regarding the minutes. There were none. A motion was made by Chief Fahd to approve the minutes. Melissa seconded the motion. CONSIDERATION OF A HANDICAP PARKING SIGN AT 121 BRESLIN AVE

The Center for Independence reviewed Ms. Jordan's application and recommended she receive the handicap sign. 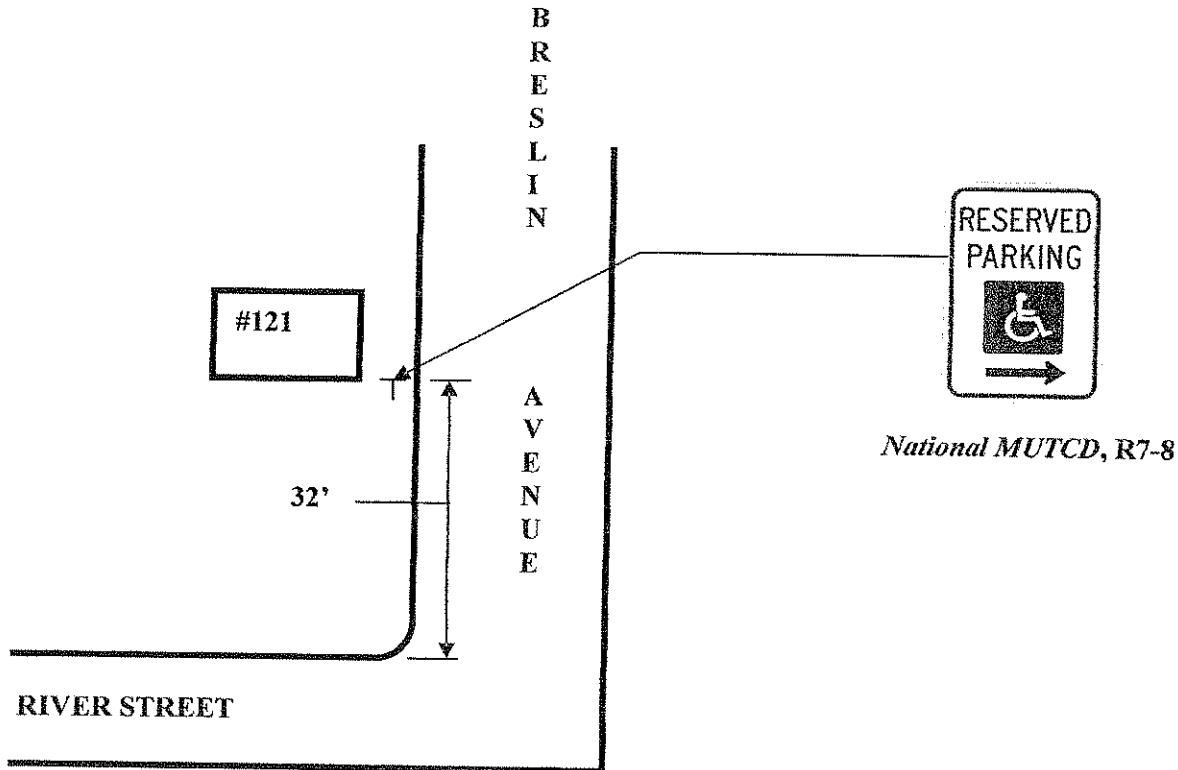

INSTALLATION:

- 1) Install a R7 - 8, *Handicap Parking*, sign on the north side of Breslin Avenue, in front of # 121 Breslin Avenue and 32' east of the River Street intersection. Said sign shall conform to the *National Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices*, be 12" by 18" in size, have a right directional arrow and be mounted at a height of 7'. Said sign shall be placed facing approaching traffic at an angle of between 30 and 45 degrees with the line of traffic flow.

INSTALLATIONS:

Install a *Farmer's Market Guide* sign at the following locations:

1. Columbia Street @ the southeast corner of Monroe Street.
2. Columbia Street @ the southwest corner of Remsen Street.
3. Columbia Street @ the northeast corner of Remsen Street.
4. Manor Avenue @ the southeast corner of Baker Avenue.
5. Manor Avenue @ the southwest corner of North Mohawk Street.
6. North Mohawk Street @ the southbound Colonie Town line.
7. North Mohawk Street @ the southwest corner of Mohawk Street.
8. Mohawk Street @ the northwest corner of Ontario Street.
9. Saratoga Street @ the south end of the Mohawk River Bridge.
10. Saratoga Street @ the northwest corner of Ontario Street.
11. Ontario Street @ the northeast corner of Remsen Street.
12. Ontario Street @ the southwest corner of Remsen Street.
13. Ontario Street @ the northeast corner of Delaware Avenue.
14. Northbound NY 787 at the southeast corner of Bridge Avenue.
15. Northbound NY 787 @ the southeast corner of Ontario Street.
16. Northbound NY 787 @ the northeast corner of Dyke Avenue.
17. Saratoga Street @ the northbound Colonie Town line.
18. Saratoga Street @ the southeast corner of Bridge Avenue.

Signs shall be as designed and manufactured by *Vital Signs*. Said signs shall have a directional arrow as required and shall be mounted at a height of 7 feet.
